As staff, we will:

- ◆ Encourage your child to be the very best that they can be in all areas of their learning
- ◆ Provide children with high quality teaching
- ◆ Ensure fairness and safety is at the heart of all that we do
- ◆ Work in collaboration with your family, listening and to responding appropriately
- ◆ Communicate effectively with you about your child's learning and their behaviours
- ◆ Equip your child with the skills needed for the world beyond Tollgate.
- ◆ Further, develop your child's independence
- ◆ Provide challenge to extend their learning in all areas of the curriculum
- ◆ Plan exciting and stimulating learning experiences

As a parent/ carer:

- ◆ Keep up to date and respond to communication from school, ie, consent letters, newsletters, Parentmail and tapestry as appropriate
- ◆ Ensure your child has got everything that they need for the day, ie uniform, PE kit, lunch box
- ◆ Ensure that your child arrives at school safely and on time
- ◆ Work in partnership with the school to support the behaviour, E Safety and Safeguarding policies
- ◆ Attend information sessions about your child's education
- ◆ Follow school procedures to inform us about your child, ie absence, first aid, changes in collection, personal details
- ◆ Support my child with home learning tasks
- ◆ Share a book with my child daily. Help them to sound out words and practise their key words
- ◆ Support my child with their home learning each week
- ◆ Encourage your child to be an independent in self-care – dressing, undressing and organising belongings

As a learner

- ◆ Follow the school rules and support my peers by acting as positive role model
- ◆ Respect the school environment and the people within it
- ◆ Wear my uniform with pride
- ◆ Share my learning with my parents/ carers
- ◆ Go to bed at a time that ensures I am ready for the day ahead
- ◆ I will be an Ambassador of Tollgate both in school and in the community
- ◆ I will challenge myself to try new activities in the learning environment
- ◆ I will manage my behaviour and make the right choices throughout the school day
- ◆ I will learn to look after my belongings
- ◆ Use IT safely (see acceptable use of ICT policy) for an appropriate length of time
