As staff, we will:

- ◆ Encourage your child to be the very best that they can be in all areas of their learning
- ◆ Provide children with high quality teaching
- ◆ Ensure fairness and safety is at the heart of all that we do
- ◆ Work in collaboration with your family, listening and to responding appropriately
- ◆ Communicate effectively with you about your child’s learning and their behaviour
- ◆ Equip your child with the skills needed for the world beyond Tollgate
- ◆ Value and promote all curriculum subjects, including the Arts
- ◆ Instil a love of language in your child—helping them to become a confident reader and writer
- ◆ Do our absolute best to ensure that your child is happy at school so that they enjoy learning

As a parent/carer:

- ◆ Keep up to date and respond to communication from school i.e., consent letters, newsletters and texts as appropriate
- ◆ Ensure your child has got everything that they need for the day, i.e. uniform, PE kit, lunch box
- ◆ Ensure that your child arrives at school safely and on time
- ◆ Work in partnership with the school to support the behaviour, E Safety and Safeguarding policies
- ◆ Attend information sessions about your child’s education
- ◆ Follow school procedures to inform us about your child, i.e. absence, first aid, changes in collection, personal details
- ◆ Support my child with home learning tasks
- ◆ Ensure my child regularly reads to an adult at home
- ◆ Use information provided by the school to help my child prepare for the Year 1 Phonics Screening Check/Year 2 Statutory Assessments
- ◆ Help my child become independent and take responsibility for their own learning

As a learner

- ◆ Follow the school rules and support my peers by acting as a positive role model
- ◆ Respect the school environment and the people within it
- ◆ Wear my uniform with pride
- ◆ Share my learning with my parents/ carers
- ◆ Go to bed at a time that ensures I am ready for the day ahead
- ◆ I will be an Ambassador of Tollgate in school and in the community
- ◆ Take an active part in school life
- ◆ Be willing to take risks and have a go!
- ◆ Be curious—ask questions about what I have learnt or what I would like to find out next
- ◆ Use IT safely (see acceptable use of ICT policy) for an appropriate length of time
